Project Purpose and Study Objectives: Statement on how this Development Grant funding will lead to the next grant submission, as well as advance the investigators' future research in aging.

Background: What is significant about the research that is being considered? What background does the research team have in this area or related areas?

Research Team: There can only be one PI who is a UMB faculty member. However other researchers, including UCR faculty, can be part of the research team and should be noted in the application.

Methods and Research Plan: Include how ongoing partnership between UMB and UCR will be facilitated.

Impact: How will the Development Grant contribute to developing and sustaining a research partnership between UCR and UMB? What's the impact on the field of gerontology?

Timeline: Consider need for IRB approval while developing timeline.
